





School Requirements for Immunization: Sixth-12th grades



Vaccines are required for Wisconsin students.* You can get a copy of the Student Immunization Record from your school or download a copy:

<https://www.dhs.wisconsin.gov/library/F-04020L.htm>. At the start of the new school year, give the complete Student Immunization Record to the school.

How do I complete the Student Immunization Record?

-  Call your doctor or local health department and make a **vaccine visit** by early summer.
-  Ask your doctor to **fill out** the Student Immunization Record and then you **sign** it.
-  **Give** the Student Immunization Record to the school at the beginning of the new school year.
-  **Call** your doctor's office or local health department if you **need help** or more information.

What vaccines and how many doses does my student need for school?

▶ Your doctor may recommend additional vaccines to keep your student healthy.

- 4 Polio**
- 4 DTaP/DTP/DT/TD**
- 3 Hepatitis B**
- 2 Varicella**
- 2 MMR**
- 1 Tdap**

*Vaccine requirements may be waived for health, religious, or personal conviction reasons.
