

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

Dear Jesus, I praise and thank You for forgiving my sins. Bless all that I do out of love for You. Amen.

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

Once when Jesus was spending time with tax collectors and sinners, He told three stories called parables. He told these parables to help people who were grumbling about Him learn why He spent time with sinners.

Today's Bible Story: Jesus Seeks the Lost





Today's Bible Story: Jesus Seeks the Lost









Maybe he went to parties - lots of parties. Soon, all of his money was gone. He had nothing left. And because there was little rain in that country, there was very little food to eat. The hungry son had no money left, so he decided to get a job.

Today's Bible Story: Jesus Seeks the Lost




A farmer hired him to feed pigs. The son was so hungry that he wanted to eat the pods that he fed to the pigs. One day he thought, my father has many servants, and they have plenty of bread to eat. Please let me work for you as one of your hired servants.” With that thought, he began to walk home.







The jealous son said, “I have served you. I have obeyed you. When have you given a party for me?” “All that I own is yours,” the father said. “You have always been here. It is right to be happy and celebrate. Your brother, who was dead, is alive. Once he was lost, but now he is found.”

How are the three stories alike?

Something or someone loved and valuable is lost. There is great rejoicing when the thing or person is found.

Why do you think that Jesus spends time with sinners?

They are lost and need someone to find them.

Jesus.

Jesus is sometimes called the Son of Man. In the meaning of our Bible Words, we find out why Jesus, the Son of Man, came to earth.




Let's pretend this shape represents you and me.

It only takes one sin to separate us from God. Like the sheep, the coin, and the son, we are lost. We are separated from God. We need someone to seek and to save us.

Do you know how he did that?

He became human. He lived perfectly for us. He died for our sins and rose again.




What are some sinful things that we do that separate us from God?

We do sinful things that we don't even realize are sins. Each of us was born sinful. We are sinful by nature. That means we must color in this entire shape.

Do you know who did that?

God or Jesus




Jesus died and rose again for sinners. God seeks you in His Word and in Baptism. In Baptism, you were marked with the cross of Christ. In Baptism, God sought you and found you. He welcomed you as His own. In Baptism, the Holy Spirit gave you saving faith.

It is wonderful news to know that we are not lost, that Jesus has found us. In heaven, there is rejoicing because we have been found!







Today's Bible Story #2: Jesus is Anointed




Simon was a proud, religious man. He was a Pharisee who had heard Jesus teach. Simon invited Jesus to eat dinner along with other guests. **While they were coming together, a woman entered the house and fell at Jesus' feet.** The woman's sins were known by all. Many people could see that she disobeyed God's laws.

Today's Bible Story: Jesus is Anointed




While at Jesus' feet, she began to cry. She took her long hair and dried the tears that fell on His feet. Then she kissed Jesus' feet and anointed His feet. **She wet them with expensive perfume.**


Simon and other people who were eating with Jesus looked at each other and said, “If this man were a prophet, **He would know what this woman is a sinner.**”

Today's Bible Story: Jesus is Anointed




Jesus, who really was a prophet, knew what they were thinking. He said, “Simon, I have a story to tell you.” Jesus told stories to help people understand more about why He came to earth. **Here is Jesus' story.**

Today's Bible Story: Jesus is Anointed




“Two people owed money to a lender. One owed 500 silver pieces. That’s a lot of money. The other person owed 50 pieces. Neither person had money to repay their debt. Since the lender knew that neither person could pay, he said that the two people did not have to pay back the money.”

At the end of this little story, Jesus asked Simon, “Which one of the people will love the lender more?” Simon answered, “I suppose the one who had been forgiven more.”

Today's Bible Story: Jesus is Anointed




Jesus said, "You are correct, Simon. Do you see this woman? I came into your house. You gave Me no water to wash My feet, but she washed My feet with her tears and dried them with her hair. **You did not greet Me with a kiss, but from the time I came in, she has not stopped kissing My feet.** You did not anoint My head with oil, but she has anointed My feet with costly perfume. I tell you, her many sins are forgiven. **She loved much, but he who is forgiven little, loves little.**

Today's Bible Story: Jesus is Anointed



Then Jesus said to the woman, “Your sins are forgiven.” The other people at the table began to whisper to each other, “Who is this man? **He forgives sins.**” Jesus said to the woman, “Your faith has saved you; go in peace.” What a wonderful gift Jesus has given this woman.



Jesus spoke the Bible words: “Your sins are forgiven.” [Luke 7:48] to the woman who anointed His feet. She knew she was sinful and needed Jesus. With these four words, Jesus forgave her sins.

Your mom was willing to pay your debt?


I know! Isn't that wonderful? I was so happy that I cried some more and gave my mom a big kiss. Now I want to make her the best picture ever. May I have those crayons?




Oh, sure.

Jesus has done so much for us that, in faith, we can respond. The woman in our Bible story responded by pouring her wonderful perfume on Jesus' feet. We say she anointed Jesus. Like the woman in our Bible story, Sisuu showed that she needed to be forgiven by making a card for her mom.

Jesus paid the debt for your sins and that, through His Spirit, He has forgiven your sins. No matter what we have done, what rule we have broken, God can and does forgive our sins and our sinfulness. Like the woman in the story, we believe in the forgiveness of sins. We confess this belief in the words of the Apostles' Creed when we say, "I believe in the forgiveness of sins."






