

A Special Meal Bible Craft

Bible Story: A Special Meal

Bible Text: Matt. 26:17-30; Luke 22: 7-20; 1 Cor. 11:23-26

Suggested Learning Outcome: This creative placemat will help children remember the reason Jesus had the last supper was because He loves you and me!

Supplies List:

Contact paper

Sequins

Light colored construction paper (yellow, light blue, pink)

Crayons

Teacher Preparation:

Write out the words “Jesus Loves You and Me” in large block letters and make copies for each student on light colored construction paper (see image). Pre-cut rectangles of contact paper approximately 12 inches x 16 inches. You will need 2 per student.



Instructions:

Step One. Have students color the “Jesus Loves You and Me” page anyway they like.

Step Two. Give children a sheet of pre-cut contact paper. Help children carefully peel away the contact paper covering. Guide the students in centering the “Jesus Loves You and Me” page (back down) onto the center of the contact paper.


Step Three. Allow children to sprinkle or place sequins all over the page and contact paper for decoration. Place the remaining piece of contact paper over the decorated paper to create a personally crafted placemat (see image).






The Last Supper Crossword Puzzle








Today, in our Bible story, we will talk about a special meal that Jesus ate with His disciples, and we will talk about how God's people celebrate that meal today.



Our Bible Story this week - “The Lord’s Supper” - is from the Book of Luke. The events take place during Holy Week. Holy Week is the time in the church Year between today and the next Sunday, when we will celebrate Easter.

Today's Bible Story: The Lord's Supper

Jesus took bread...And He took a cup. [Matthew 26:26-27]

Today's Bible Story: The Lord's Supper




On the first day of Holy Week, Jesus rode into Jerusalem on a donkey. Many people in Jerusalem were happy to see Jesus; they wanted Him to be their king. They waved palm leaves and put their coats on the ground so that Jesus, who was seated on a donkey, could ride over them. As Jesus went by, they called out “Hosanna,” which means “Lord save us.”

Today's Bible Story: The Lord's Supper



Later that same week, it was time to celebrate the Passover meal. This celebration started on Thursday evening. Jesus asked Peter and John to prepare a room so that He could eat the Passover meal with His disciples.

Today's Bible Story: The Lord's Supper



To do this, Jesus said that they should enter the city gate and follow a man carrying a water jar. They were to enter the house that he entered. Peter and John were to tell the master of that house that Jesus wanted to eat the Passover with His disciples in the guest room. Jesus said that the master would then show them a large upper room. They would prepare the meal in that room.

Today's Bible Story: The Lord's Supper



Peter and John obeyed Jesus. Later, at night, Jesus and His disciples came to eat that special meal. During the meal, Jesus said to the disciples, “I wanted to eat this Passover meal with you before I suffer and die.”

Today's Bible Story: The Lord's Supper



Jesus took bread. He gave thanks to God for the bread. He broke it apart and gave it to His disciples, saying, "This is My body, which is given for you. Do this in remembrance of Me."

Today's Bible Story: The Lord's Supper



Then Jesus took a cup filled with wine. He said, “This cup I poured for you is My blood.” With the bread and the cup on that night, Jesus began a new meal called the Lord’s Supper. The Church celebrates this meal today and calls it the Sacrament of the Altar.

Today's Bible Story: The Lord's Supper



In the Lord's Supper, the family of God gathers around the altar. Because of Jesus' death and resurrection, sins are forgiven. Through the Lord's Supper, God forgives sins.

Today's Bible Story: The Lord's Supper



You are not old enough to receive the Lord's Supper. But soon you will learn more about the Sacrament of the Altar. While you watch and wait beside your parents or other adults, you can remember that God has forgiven your sins too.

Today's Bible Story: The Lord's Supper



When you were baptized, you received the forgiveness of sins as a gift. Jesus won this gift for you. He is the Lamb of God who died for you and for me. We are saved from God's punishment, and like the people long ago, we sing, "Hosanna!"

Bible Words: “Jesus took bread...And He took a cup. [Matthew 26: 26-27]

Through Jesus’ sacrifice on the cross, we have the forgiveness of sins as God’s gift. Because God forgives our sins, we also have life forever with Jesus. Through the Lord’s Supper, believers receive the forgiveness of sins.

In the Lord’s Supper, Jesus used things His disciples could see and taste. He used bread and wine. Our Bible Words tell us the thing we see in the Lord’s Supper. What can we see in Baptism?

Water

Water, bread and wine are visible elements. They are things that we can see.

If your sin caused Jesus to suffer and die, put your thumb up.




Yes, Jesus gave His body and blood for you.


If you believe in the forgiveness of sins, put your thumb up.




Yes, Jesus loves you. Yes, Jesus died and rose for you. Yes, Jesus is your Passover Lamb.



Today, in our lesson, we talked about the Passover meal Jesus shared with His disciples on the day before He died on the cross. Jesus broke bread, saying it was His body Jesus gave wine, saying it was His blood In this meal, called the Lord's Supper, Jesus gives the forgiveness of sins.






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


The Last Supper Crossword Puzzle
