GIFT OF TREES: A few years ago a number of individuals and groups donated money toward the replanting of various trees around our Church

campus. With some of the leftover funds, a plaque made of solid black walnut was crafted in memory of the individuals commemorated. Before the plaque is hung in a public location, the congregation is invited to view it on display in the back of the nave. Thank you to those who contributed in memory of friends and loved ones! It is also an investment in the ongoing stewardship of our church property.

MEMORIAL SERVICE FOR PATRICK MALONE:

On Saturday, April 30, a 10:30 a.m. memorial service will be held for the Rev. Patrick Malone at Elm Grove Evangelical Lutheran Church, with his Anglican Bishop Julian Dobbs officiating. Fr Malone was the pastor for Holy Cross Anglican Church during much of the time they sojourned among us at EGL after being expelled from their building (the old St Edmunds church) on Watertown Plank in Elm Grove. Malone died on Easter Tuesday. Because the family expects a large turnout for the service, and because of their enduring appreciation for us at EGL, they sought

permission to hold the service here.
