On your smart-phone or tablet, download the free mobile app - “**Instant Church Directory**” - available through any online app store. Create your login using your email address\* and create a unique password for yourself in order to sign in.

On your computer, go to [members.InstantChurchDirectory.com](http://members.InstantChurchDirectory.com) and follow the prompts under “Sign In” to “Create a login now.” Please remember, you must confirm your email address\* and a unique password (as above).

**\*Note that you MUST use the same email address that is on file with the EGL church office to log in the first time!** Contact Amy Stroh if you have problems with this!

Once logged in, find “Edit My Family” then check the information provided. Make sure details are correct for each person in your family, including address, emails, phone numbers, etc. (note that ONLY EGL members can see this information).
