GUEST PREACHER SUNDAY: We welcome the Rev Tyler McMiller as our guest preacher this Sunday morning. Tyler is the sole LCMS pastor in Italy, where he provides Word and Sacrament ministry, Bible study, and catechism classes, all in Italian, to groups of Lutherans scattered throughout the Peninsula — in Naples, Rome, Florence, Piacenza and Padua. Tyler also mentors three men in Italy who are studying to become Lutheran pastors through an online Lutheran seminary based in Riga, Latvia. Through this work, Tyler's goal is to help geographically isolated Lutherans across Italy establish house churches, just like in the times of the apostles. Tyler was born in Waukesha, Wis., although his family served as missionaries in Latin America for 15 years. He and his family were also members at EGL for a number of years. His wife Yanela was born and raised in the Dominican Republic. She has a degree in education and has worked as a preschool director. They have two daughters -- Lia and Alessia.
