However, if you'd like to get your news delivered a little bit straighter and from a decidedly Christian perspective, I can recommend the app **The World and Everything in It.** Monday through Friday you will find a 25-30 minute report of important news, plus regular segments on the market and economy (Mondays), developments around the world (Wednesdays), and cultural events and movies (Fridays). It is safe to have on in the car while driving kids also. On Saturdays there are also long-form interviews with individuals on relevant topics. For instance, last Saturday featured an interview on the effects of smart phones and social media on child development. This was a fantastic interview and ought to get wide circulation.
